CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

10. Eligibility

Participation is open to all natural persons who are nationals of and legal persons [participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers] which are effectively established in a Member State of the European Union or in a eligible country or territory as defined under the Regulation (EU) No 236/2014 establishing common rules and procedures for the implementation of the Union's instruments for external action (CIR) for the applicable instrument under which the contract is financed (see also heading 23 below). Participation is also open to international organisations.]

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

The following selection criteria will be applied to the tenderers. In the case of tenders submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole. if not specified otherwise. The selection criteria will not be applied to natural persons and single-member companies when they are sub-contractors.

1) Economic and financial capacity of the tenderer (based on item 3 of the tender form). In case of tenderer being a public body, equivalent information should be provided. The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last three financial years for which accounts have been closed.

financial reference criteria for <u>legal</u> persons:

- annual turnover of the tenderer must be in at least one year (in the last 3 years) equal or exceed the 100% of annualised maximum budget of the contract (the budget stated in the financial offer of the bidder);
- luck of debts to local and national budgets 9 (certificate or other proof)
- 2) **Professional capacity of the tenderer** (based on items 4 and 5 of the tender form).

professional criteria for <u>legal</u> persons:

- Contractor must have implemented at least 2 similar projects in water losses reduction and additional related services in the last 10 years (proof of completion)
- Minimum 1 project implemented in Moldova or Romania (proof of completion)

Reference from projects carried out in the Republic of Moldova or in Romania over the past 10 years will be highly appreciated.

<u>3) Technical capacity of tenderer</u> (based on items 6 of the tender form). The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last 5 years preceding the submission deadline.

technical criterion for <u>legal</u> persons:

• At least 2 key experts with training in the reference field. The proposed team must possess the general and specific skills and experience necessary to fully perform the tasks set out in the Terms of Reference. (CV to be provided).

This means that the service contract the tenderer refers to could have been started at any time during the indicated period but it does not necessarily have to be completed during that period, nor implemented during the entire period. Tenderers are allowed to refer either to service contracts completed within the reference period (although started earlier) or to service contracts not yet completed. Only the portion satisfactorily completed during the reference period will be taken into consideration. This portion will have to be supported by documentary evidence (statement or certificate from the entity which awarded the contract, proof of payment) also

detailing its value. If a tenderer has implemented the service contract in a consortium, the percentage that the tenderer has successfully completed must be clear from the documentary evidence, together with a description of the nature of the services provided if the selection criteria relating to the pertinence of the experience have been used.

20. How tenders may be submitted

21. Alteration or withdrawal of tenders

Tenderers may alter or withdraw their tenders by written notification prior to the deadline for submission of tenders. No tender may be altered after this deadline.

Any such notification of alteration or withdrawal shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with point 9 of the instructions to tenderers. The outer envelope (and the relevant inner envelope if used) must be marked 'Alteration' or 'Withdrawal' as appropriate.
