


Bio-Diff RTU kit


BioGram Histo kit






Colloidal Iron kit

Six-reagent kit used for visualiziation of carboxylated and sulphated groups of acid mucopolysaccharides and proteogycans. This method can be combined with the P.A.S. method; that way glycogen and neutral mucopolysaccharides would get differentially stained characteristically magenta.





Congo Red Highman kit

Three-reagent kit for staining amyloids, characteristic for use of alkaline solution as differentiation medium in order to avoid undesirable non-specific coloration of cellular substances. Amyloid deposits display apple green birefringence with polarized light.








Congo Red Puchtler kit

Three-reagent kit for staining amyloids, characteristic by its high ionic strength and pH enhancing specificity of Congo Red dye binding to amyloid clusters. Method developed by Puchtler remains the gold standard for amyloids in tissue sections. Amyloid clusters have the property of double refraction that enables green coloration under polarized light.



Elastica-Van Gieson kit

Four-reagent kit for staining elastic fibers and differentiation between elastic tissue, collagen and other types of connective tissue. The rapid method enables a satisfactory result with shorter section staining time.
