Submitted in response to the UNDP Terms of Reference RFQ26/03298: International Expert Training Services in Textbook Design and Development

Confirmation Letter

The experts of Avita Publishing House (AS Bit), operating in the Republic of Estonia – Ly Rammo, Kärt Mattisen, Esta Erit and Elo Reinik – delivered a training programme on 14–15 April 2026, at the invitation of the Ministry of Education and Research of the Republic of Moldova, for 35 local mathematics teachers, prospective textbook authors, and publishers.

Ly Rammo has served as a publishing director since 1998. The other three experts are experienced mathematics teachers and methodologists, authors of mathematics textbooks, and developers of curricula and digital learning materials.

The training programme formed part of Moldova’s national curriculum reform process and aimed to strengthen the capacity of textbook authors and publishers in the development of curriculum-based educational content.

The training, “Modular Structure of Mathematics Education, Internal Logic of the Curriculum and Value-Based Education”, had the following objective: As a result of the training, participants would be able to plan and analyse mathematics teaching based on a modular structure and the internal logic of the curriculum, integrating the principles of values education and teaching practices based on conscious, reflective, and respectful communication into mathematics teaching, thereby supporting learners’ personal development and social responsibility.

The learning outcomes of the training were as follows: analyse mathematics teaching as a whole, taking into account the connections between modules and the gradual development of mathematical concepts at different school levels; explain the role of values in the learning process and the opportunities for mathematics education to support values education through everyday teaching; design the internal structure of a mathematics teaching module (objectives, key concepts, learning activities, assessment) in a manner that creates opportunities for recognising and reflecting on values; create communication and discussion situations in mathematics education that support learners’ value awareness, sense of responsibility, and respectful cooperation; and use problem-solving and modelling-based tasks that connect mathematical thinking with social, cultural, and human values.

The training was delivered in-person and employed a variety of active learning methods, including lecture-discussions, guided group work, analysis and planning of practical tasks, exchange of experiences, and reflection. Following the training, the experts submitted written

training materials, including sample textbook chapters and tasks of varying levels of difficulty. The training was conducted in Russian.

The training was implemented within the framework of the project “Support to Strengthen Strategic Communication Capacity and Resilience Against Disinformation, Foreign Information Manipulation and Interference in the Republic of Moldova”.

I hereby confirm that the training fully achieved its objectives and demonstrated that the editors and experts of Avita Publishing House are highly competent professionals in their field and effective trainers.
