MOTOROLA IMPRES™ 2 BATTERY WARRANTY

1) WORKMANSHIP¹:

- 48 months

2) CAPACITY²:

- Warranted to maintain 80% of rated capacity for 24 months when charged exclusively in IMPRES 2 chargers
- Warranted to maintain 80% of rated capacity for 18 months when charged exclusively in IMPRES chargers; warranted to maintain 80% of rated capacity for 12 months when charged in non IMPRES chargers

MOTOROLA ORIGINAL® BATTERY WARRANTY

1) WORKMANSHIP¹:

- 48 months for Motorola Original® batteries

2) CAPACITY²:

- Warranted to maintain 80% of rated capacity for 12 months

MOTOROLA IMPRES™ BATTERY WARRANTY

1) WORKMANSHIP¹:

- 48 months

2) CAPACITY²:

- Warranted to maintain 80% of rated capacity for 18 months when charged exclusively in IMPRES chargers
- Warranted to maintain 80% of rated capacity for 12 months when charged exclusively in non IMPRES chargers

MAG ONE BATTERY WARRANTY

1) WORKMANSHIP¹:

- 12 months

2) CAPACITY²:

- Warranted to maintain 80% of rated capacity for 12 months

This Battery Warranty is valid for purchases in the U.S. and Canada only.

¹ For a battery that Motorola Solutions determines does not meet the workmanship warranty because either the: i) battery seam opens, ii) battery has contact problems with either the applicable two-way radio or battery charger due to misalignment or plastic residue blocking the battery's contacts, or iii) battery clip retention feature (if applicable) breaks, then Motorola Solutions will provide a replacement battery, whose own warranty will extend only for the remaining warranty period of the original battery.
