Danfoss Heating Solutions statement concerning: RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC

It is Danfoss' clear objective to ensure that customers get high quality and reliable products as well as the opportunity to dispose of worn out products in an environmentally sound manner.

The RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substance) directive forbids the use of lead, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, mercury and flame retardants PBB and PBDE in electrical/electronic equipment – which amounts to a technical and production challenge when applied to some Danfoss components. The EU authorities do not impose RoHS requirements on components manufacturer like Danfoss. Only electrical and electronic equipment fall within the scope of the RoHS directive.

Nevertheless, each Danfoss division has a programme to completely eliminate the target toxic substance, and will proactively implement RoHS compliant design.

Danfoss Heating Solutions are therefore pleased to inform that Danfoss self acting radiator thermostats and valves comply with the EU directive 2002/95/EC (RoHS).
