The Republic of Moldova has received financing from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria toward the cost of the Strengthening Tuberculosis control and reducing AIDS related mortality in the Republic of Moldova, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for procurement of **Digital radiographic system (with vertical bucky stand)**.



7. All Bids must be accompanied by a **Bid-Securing Declaration**.
8. Bids must be submitted **exclusively electronically**, within the period established by SIA RSAP. Bids will be opened **automatically** at the deadline established by SIA RSAP.
