

EUROPEAN SINGLE PROCUREMENT DOCUMENT FORM

1. The European single procurement document (hereinafter, ESPD) is a declaration on personal responsibility, by which the economic operator confirms the fulfilment of the qualification and selection criteria necessary in the public procurement procedures in the Republic of Moldova.
 2. The form shall be completed, electronically signed and sent to the contracting authority upon submission of the tender.
 3. An ESPD submitted by the economic operator in a previous public procurement procedure may be reused, provided that the information contained in the form is correct and valid at the time of its submission.
 4. The tenderer who submits false information or supporting documents in the ESPD does not confirm the information indicated in the submitted document is excluded from the public procurement procedure and / or may be liable in accordance with the law.
 5. The ESPD form consists of 7 chapters, namely:
 - 1) Chapter I. Information on the public procurement procedure and the contracting authority / entity;
 - 2) Chapter II. Information about the economic operator;
 - 3) Chapter III. Reasons for exclusion from the public procurement procedure;
 - 4) Chapter IV. Qualification and selection criteria of economic operators;
 - 5) Chapter V. General requirements for the selection criteria of economic operators;
 - 6) Chapter VI. Pre-selection of candidates for the procedure for awarding the public procurement contract;
 - 7) Chapter VII. Final statements.
 1. Submission of the ESPD form upon submission of the tender that does not comply with the requirements set out in the Award Documentation will lead to the rejection of the tender.
