

8 USER INSTRUCTIONS

The information in this section of the manual regards the user or professional personnel (see par. 1.3). After the appliance has been installed in accordance with the instructions of section 3, it is ready for use.

8.1 CONTROLS

The appliance is equipped with the control panel ADVANCED Fig.10

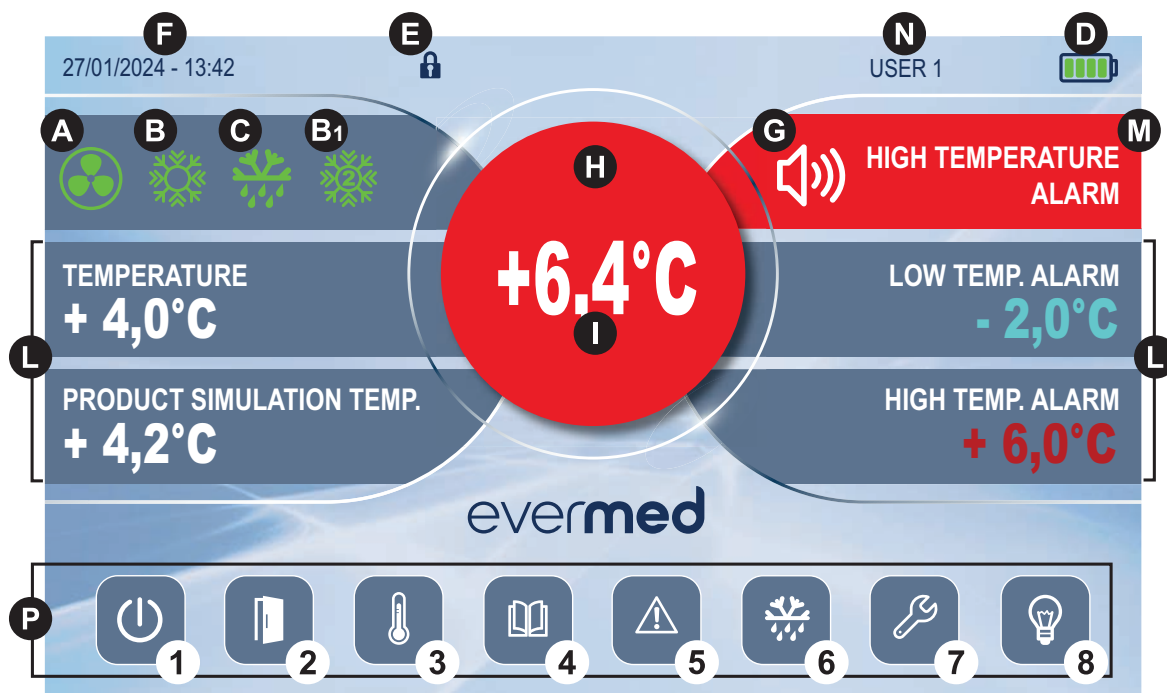

8.1.1 Description of the control panel ADVANCED and operating instructions Fig.10

The appliance is equipped with a 7" high definition touch control panel.

All commands are displayed and managed through the panel display.

The display has the icons listed below.

According to their status (on/off), the icons give information on the current operation of the appliance.

- **A** FAN: on when evaporator fan is running
- **B** COMPRESSOR: on when compressor is running
- **B1** COMPRESSOR 2: on when compressor 2 (if present) is running
- **C** DEFROSTING: on during defrosting
- **D** BATTERY: shows the current battery charge status
- **E** DISPLAY LOCK: on when the display is in lock mode
- **F** DATE/TIME: shows date and time
- **G** BUZZER: on when an alarm is in progress
- **H** ALARM WARNING: on (RED) to signal an alarm in progress. This warning is always accompanied by the relevant alarm description **M**
- **I** CURRENT TEMPERATURE: displays the current internal temperature
- **L** SETTINGS: shows and changes the set temperature value, the relative low and high temperature alarms and if present (optional) the product simulation temperature
- **N** USER: shows the name of the user using the appliance

In addition to the icons listed above, in the control panel there is the MAIN MENU **P**. This menu consists of 5/8 keys (depending on the series/model of the appliance) whose functions and characteristics are illustrated in paragraph 8.3.
