### 3D PRINTING AND ADDITIVE MANUFACTURING



There are currently three industrial-sized 3D printers located in Moldova—two 180HSE and one 280i HSE Essentium (a Nexa3D company) printers—along with one desktop Prusa MK3S+ printer. A demonstration of these printers and their capabilities was previously held at JDAMMT. Additionally, we have a 3D printer located in Ukraine, where we are planning to conduct a showcase, as well as at KVG's headquarters in Gettysburg, PA.

KVG was tasked with providing comprehensive base operation support (laundry, internet, printing services), expeditious procurement and lease and horizontal construction services in support of the US Army 2nd Cavalry Regimental Engineer Squadron on its joint training exercise with the Army of the Republic of Moldova.

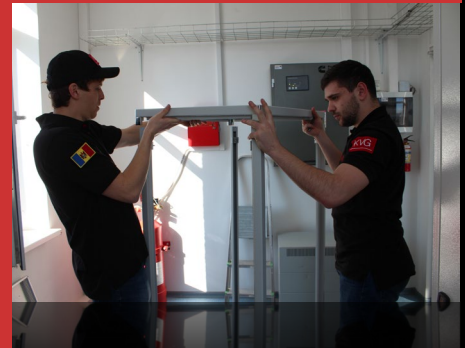
KVG was tasked with procurement and delivery of medical supplies to the U.S Embassy, Moldova. There were 9 different items with varied technical specifications and a total of 177 units.

- **Under Contract Number N6817121P2050**

KVG was tasked with a Multi-Year, Nationwide contract. KVG carried out improvement of WMD identification nationwide Provision of wide scope of services including A&E, Design/Build, Electronics, Procurement, Training, Interpreters, & Staffing.

- **KVG is actively consulting, in partnership with ADS Inc., for the local Moldovan Railway Authority on a Railway System Modernization Project.**

This initiative, sponsored by the US Department of State, is planned as part of the Export Control and Related Border Security Assistance (EXBS) Project, aiming to enhance the operational capabilities and security measures of the Moldovan railway system.



- **Under Contract HDTRA11-11D-0007,**

KVG headed the improvement of WMD identification nationwide provision of a wide scope of services including A&E, Design/Build, Electronics, Procurement, Training, Interpreters, & Staffing from 2014 to 2018.

- **The Weapons of Mass Destruction Project (WMD PPP) is sponsored by DTRA in the Republic of Moldova.** The KVG Team, in partnership with Raytheon Co. adeptly integrated system requirements encompassing security and surveillance, long-distance radio, and remote internet connectivity, as well as the design, engineering, construction, and installation of six surveillance towers for the Border Police. Key deliverables included conducting feasibility studies before constructing the surveillance towers, identifying, negotiating, procuring, managing customs clearance, and delivering products and services to the Moldovan Border Police and other beneficiaries within the Ministry of Interior. A notable aspect of this project was the successful collaboration with the local beneficiary—the National Agency for Energy Regulation—particularly in environmental compliance, ensuring proper property transfer with appropriately cleared documentation in line with local legislation.

- **Training Staffing and logistics support under CTRIC III GNS Program in Ukraine, 2019 to date.**

- **Supply and delivery of container buildings and Mitsubishi I200 trucks to Moldova with ADS Inc as the customer during the period of September 2023- April 2024,** where KVG supplied 8 brand new Mitsubishi I200 to the client. Each vehicle had a checklist supplied outlining the specifications and was checked throughout the stages of delivery. The delivery was made by our KVG people based in our Moldovan office.

- **Under Purchase Orders 1327236 and 1327237 KVG procured and delivered 6 Outlander vehicles and generators to Ukraine.**
