OSAGAU AG (Reg. No. CHE-283.867.262, Chamerstrasse 172, 6300 Zug, Switzerland) hereby submits its offer for the supply of Jet A1 aviation fuel under the above-referenced procedure, for the full estimated quantity of approximately 29,000 tonnes ($\pm 10\%$) over the period September 2026 – January 2027, on the terms set out in our enclosed Technical Specification (Annex 22) and Price Specification (Annex 23).

Under Swiss law, the wholesale trading of petroleum products, including aviation fuel, is not subject to a dedicated state licence. Commercial trading activity falls under the general freedom of trade and commerce guaranteed by Article 27 of the Federal Constitution of the Swiss Confederation (Bundesverfassung, BV; SR 101), and the only formal requirement applicable to OSAGAU AG's activity is incorporation and entry in the Commercial Register as an Aktiengesellschaft under Articles 620 et seq. of the Swiss Code of Obligations (Obligationenrecht, OR; SR 220) — satisfied and evidenced by the apostilled extract from the Commercial Register of the Canton of Zug, Reg. No. CHE-283.867.262 (Apostille of the Chancery of State of the Canton of Zug, No. 3364/26, dated 2 March 2026). A licence ("Bewilligung als zugelassenes Lager") is required under Articles 27 et seq. of the Federal Act on the Taxation of Mineral Oil (Mineralölsteuergesetz, MinöStG; SR 641.61) and Articles 70–71 of its Ordinance (MinöStV; SR 641.611) only for parties that physically operate a bonded, duty-suspension warehouse for mineral oil products on Swiss territory. This does not apply to OSAGAU AG, which trades Jet A1 on FCA terms ex the supplying refinery's/terminal's loading point and does not store, refine or import the fuel into Switzerland. For the same reason, the mandatory-stockpiling regime under the Federal Act on National Economic Supply (Landesversorgungsgesetz, LVG; SR 531) is not triggered either. Jet A1 aviation fuel is also not a controlled or strategic good under the Goods Control Act (Güterkontrollgesetz, GKG; SR
