Functionality	
Instructions as to how it works	1. Document and describe the identified change requests in the list
	2. Specify for each request the status, the regulation, etc. Use the predefined alternatives in the table
	3. The tab "Graph, status" shows the number of requests and their respective status.
	4. The tab "Graph, priority" shows the distribution of the open requests with the highest priority (must) assigned to the respective decision fora. All the columns Regulation, Priority and Decision forum need to be filled out for this graph to work. Rejected or closed items are not shown. I the second graph shows the number of requests of each kind and their priority.
	· The requests in the list can be sorted using Excel functionality.
	· Specify the request number manually (if you use automatic numbering, filtering and sorting will not work)
	· The list accomodates 100 requests
	· If additional rows are required, - unlock the sheet "List" via Review ► Unprotect sheet - Select a whole row where the new row is required. "Right click"; choose Insert row
	NOTE! Before ending, lock the sheet via Review ► Protect sheet
