General requirements for usage of US devices in combination with Storz Medical shock wave devices. Revision 3.0

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1 General

The new ultrasound device SAMSUNG HS30 is used with STORZ MEDICAL lithotripters. Therefore, a special ultrasound probe for inline use and a software for crosshair display was developed by Samsung. The aim of this test is to prove that the generation of the crosshairs used for targeting the shock waves by the so called StorM Link data link is correct and not interrupted when using a RS232 to USB converter with a fibre optic cable for isolation.




Figure 4: cable clip inside

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4 Practical Test

Connect the ultrasound device to the lithotripter and place it in proximity of the shockwave source. During the release of the shockwaves no time out error should be displayed or no other incorrect behaviour of the device should be observed. The shockwave should be released at the highest energy level. A treatment was performed with 4000 shocks on highest energy level. Storm Link and transducer cable are tight together in parallel to simulate highest interference-prone.




Figure 7: total number of shockwaves
