

Section 2.5 Touch Screen

The Touch Screen enables the operator to control the procedure, gather status information, and handle alerts. The screen displays prompts to enter information or perform other tasks.

Using the Touch Screen

This section describes typical interactive elements that may appear on the Touch Screen, and how the operator uses them to perform tasks. Interactive elements include screens, overlays, tabs, pages, buttons, and keypads.



Note: Touch Screen entries should conform to the instrument's administrative settings. Visual indicators (typically orange text or highlights) notify the operator of an entry that is outside of the administrative settings range.

Screens

Screens contain elements such as buttons, tabs, prompts, and status information.

Tabs

Tabs appear on screens and provide access to additional information and controls associated with the screen. Touching a tab opens a page.
