

Ultra wide tolerance coupling SERIES 3100

Enables the mechanical jointing of pipes made of different materials and of various outside diameters.



Description

- Ultra wide tolerance range: an average of 40 mm.
- Small number of models for a Nominal Diameter.
- Reliability:
 - Permanent leak tight joint when compressing the gasket between the end-flange and the sleeve onto the pipe surface.
 - Independent sealing compression on each socket end.
 - Anticorrosion protection: epoxy powder coating 120 µm and Dacromet® 500 Gr.B for the bolts.
- Ease of installation:
 - Angular deflection $\pm 10^\circ$,
 - Easy mounting with interchangeability of bolts direction,
 - Accommodates misalignment,
 - Setting gap.
- Conformity to standards:
 - NFA 48 830: Foundry products - Spheroidal graphite cast iron fittings for PVC drinking water pipes under pressure.
 - EN 545: Ductile iron pipes, fittings, accessories and their joints for water pipelines – requirements and test methods.
 - ISO 2531: Ductile iron pipes, fittings, accessories and their joints for water applications.
- Approval:
 - Drinking water approved.
- Nota:

This coupling does not resist to longitudinal forces and pipe pull out will occur. Ensure adequate restraint is provided

- Maximal working pressure: PN 16.
- Temperatures: +0°C to +60°C.
- Torque: 60 to 70 Nm.

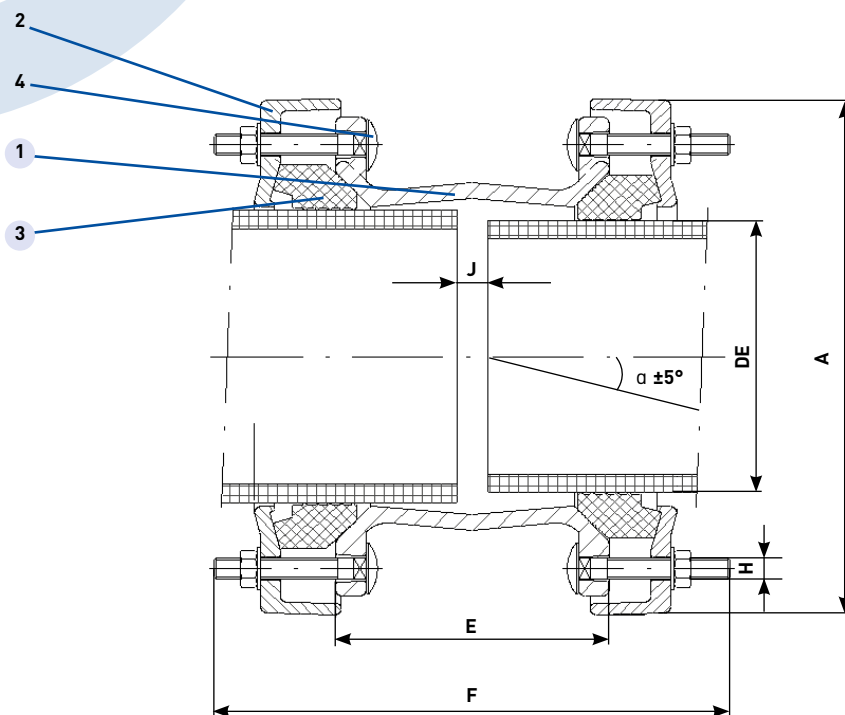
Applications
