


Connect the TV plate to the back of the TV






(1a) 75x75 mm up to 100x100 mm hole pattern






Hole pattern 100x200 mm up to 400x400 mm:

Connect the 4 Adaptors to the TV Plate with Z8 screws and Z9 nut.






Connect the TV Plate with the Adaptors to the TV in all 4 mounting holes




Install the Bracket on the Wall

Measure the distance between the location of the TV's mounting holes' center and the bottom of the TV, in order to set the required height of the TV












Use a Stud Finder








Weight test

Apply force on the upper part of the Bracket and make sure it is well connected













 $ig(oldsymbol{6} ig)$ Release the upper screw 3mm out



 $ig(\ {f 7} \, ig)$ Hang the TV with the TV Plate carefully on the Bracket.








Make sure the TV plate's upper screw is positioned properly in the designated bracket slot




Connect the TV with the TV Plate to the Bracket


Tighten screw #1 and assembled screw #2 with the washer














Level the TV according to your needs






Move the TV - by pulling/pushing the Bracket (A).Be careful when you move the TV by the screen.









BACKSCREEN CONNECTION POSITIONING OPTIONS


All TV backscreen connections are in millimeters (Width × Height).


There are a few sizes of TV plates available.


The backscreen connections in position 1 are included in some of the different TV plates, according to their size, and do not require the use of the 4 adapters (marked in blue).








