**6. Nature of contract**

Unit price

**7. Contract description**

Purchase of 1 (one) unit of Minibus. The vehicle is intended for the transport of firefighters, rescue personnel and accompanying equipment from fire and rescue units to intervention sites, training activities and operational missions. The vehicle shall be designed for intensive operational use, ensuring the safe, rapid and efficient transportation of personnel under both normal and emergency conditions, including cross-border activities.

## CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

### 10. Legal basis, eligibility and rules of origin

The legal basis of this procedure is Regulation (EU) N° 2021/947 establishing the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe (NDICI)<sup>1</sup> See Annex A2 of the practical guide. Participation is open to all natural persons who are nationals of and legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping – consortium — of tenderers) which are effectively established in a Member State of the European Union or in a eligible country or territory as defined under the Regulation (EU) N° 2021/947. All supplies under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries.

### 11. Number of tenders

No more than one tender may be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting a tender). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one tender, all tenders in which that person has participated will be excluded.

### 12. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the tender form, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in Section 2.6.10.1 of the practical guide (PRAG), that they do not fall under the exclusions of Art. 16 and Art. 79 of Law no. 131/2015, and that they are not in a situation of conflict of interest or in any of the situations of exclusion from EU-funded contracts (including EDES and the national Prohibition List).

### 13. Sub-contracting

Sub-contracting is permitted. The tenderer and, where applicable, the entities on whose capacities it has relied in relation to the criteria relating to economic and financial capacity shall be jointly and severally liable for the performance of the contract. The tenderer must indicate in its tender the parts of the contract that it intends to sub-contract and the identity of the sub-contractors.

### 15. Implementation period of the tasks

The subject matter of the contract is the supply, manufacture, and delivery of 1 (one) unit of Minibus. The vehicle must be delivered on DDP terms to the premises of the official dealer in Moldova or the Regional Department of Emergency Situations ATU Gagauzia, located at

7 Novaia Street, Comrat, Moldova, no later than 17 September 2026. The implementation period starts from the date of contract signature and ends with the provisional acceptance of the supplied goods.

## **SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA**

### **16. Selection criteria**

The following selection criteria will be applied to the tenderers:

Economic and financial capacity of the tenderer (based on item 3 of the tender form). The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last three financial years for which accounts have been closed:

The average annual turnover of the tenderer for the last 3 years for which accounts have been closed must exceed 59500,00 EUR;

Current ratio (current assets/current liabilities) in the last year for which accounts have been closed must be at least 1.

Professional capacity of the tenderer (based on item 4 of the tender form). The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last three years preceding the submission deadline:

At least 3 staff currently work for the tenderer in fields related to this contract (supply of special intervention vehicles, automotive engineering, or technical maintenance of specialized transport).

The Bidder must have at least one nationally authorized service center in the Republic of Moldova and guarantee permanent technical assistance with a response time of maximum 24 hours.

Technical capacity of tenderer (based on items 5 and 6 of the tender form). The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last three years preceding the submission deadline:

The tenderer has delivered supplies under at least one contract with a budget of at least 30000,00 EUR in the field of specialized vehicles, passenger vans, or emergency response vehicles.

The offered vehicle must strictly comply with the technical requirements for the 1 (one) unit of "Minibus" (including requirements for an 8-seater capacity, minimum 230 HP diesel engine, automatic gearbox, and integrated acoustic and optical warning system).

### **17. Award criteria**

The lowest price, provided that the goods delivered comply with the technical specifications.

## **TENDERING**

### **18. Deadline for submission of tenders**

The deadline for submission of tenders is July 6, 2026. Any tender received by the contracting authority after this deadline will not be considered. Tenders must be submitted exclusively through the

Automated Information System "State Register of Public Procurement" (SIA RSAP).

#### **19. Tender format and details to be provided**

Tenders must be submitted using the standard tender form for a supply contract included in the tender dossier. The tender must be accompanied by the following documentation:

A technical offer (Annex II + III) providing a detailed description of the 1 (one) unit of Minibus (including requirements for an 8-seater capacity, minimum 230 HP diesel engine, automatic gearbox, and integrated acoustic and optical warning system) offered, including all necessary technical documentation and sheets for the equipment.

A financial offer (Annex IV) presented in EUR, calculated on a DDP basis (Incoterms 2020).

The tender guarantee of 595,00 EUR (1% of the budget).

The 'Tender form for a supply contract', together with Annex 1 'Declaration on honour on exclusion and selection criteria'.

Technical and professional capacity evidence, and a list of equipment for the 1 (one) Minibus with precise indication of make, model, and year of manufacture (minimum 2026).

#### **20. How tenders may be submitted**

Tenders must be submitted exclusively through the Automated Information System "State Register of Public Procurement" (SIA RSAP). The deadline for submission of tenders is July 6, 2026.

#### **21. Alteration or withdrawal of tenders**

Tenderers may alter or withdraw their tenders by written notification through the Automated Information System "SIA RSAP" prior to the deadline for submission of tenders.

#### **22. Operational language**

All written communications for this tender procedure and contract must be in English.

#### **23. Additional information**

The financial data to be provided by the applicant in the standard application form must be expressed in EUR. If applicable, where a candidate refers to amounts originally expressed in a different currency, the conversion to EUR shall be made in accordance with the InforEuro exchange rate of May 2026, which can be found at the following address: <http://ec.europa.eu/budget/graphs/inforeuro.html> .
