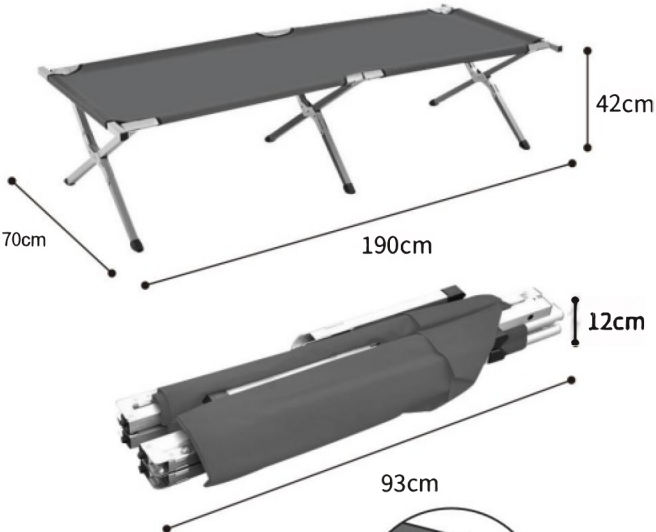


FOLDING COT INSTRUCTION MANUAL

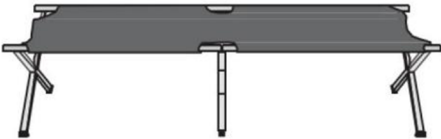

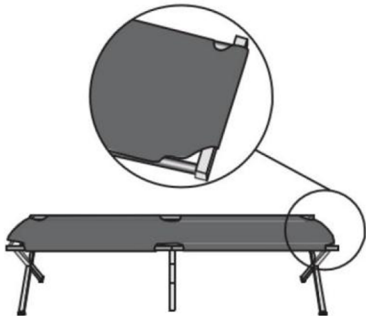
Assembly Steps:



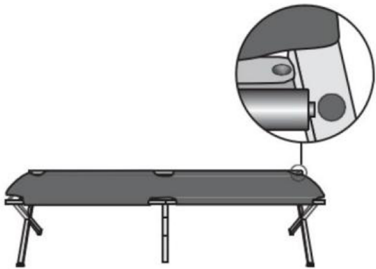
STEP 1
Unfold the cot so that the side rails are straight and all the legs line up on one side.



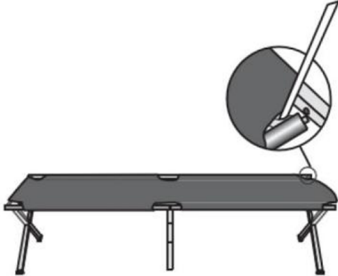
STEP 2
Stand the cot up so the canvas is still somewhat loose in the middle.



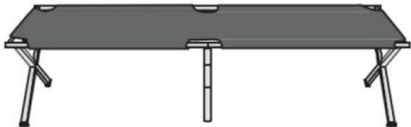
STEP 3
Slide the support rails into each sleeve at either end of the cot.



STEP 4
Line up the plastic buffers so they are in line with the holes in the support rails and snap it on. Repeat for 3 of the 4 holes.



STEP 5
For the last hole, the fabric will be very tight and it will be difficult to get the plastic buffer to fit into the hole. Use a pole or stick as a lever and insert it between the frame and the support rail.



STEP 6
Pull the long end of the lever until the support rail can be moved into position to fit the plastic buffer. Your cot is now ready for use!

Note: pictures shown above are for illustration purposes only. Actual product may vary.



Read instructions and warnings before set up and use.

1. Check and make sure the cot is not damaged prior to use. Do not use the cot if it is damaged .
2. Beware of moving parts and hinges when setting up or folding the cot. Avoid pinch points.
3. Use the cot within its weight limit.
4. Use on even or hard surface. Check if the cot is set up properly before use.
5. Do not sit or lie on the cot with great impact, or shake it violently .
6. Do not stand or jump on the cot. Do not sit on the frames but on the the fabric only.
7. Not for use by unsupervised children.
8. Care should be exercised near open flame or burning cigarette, as some material of this cot is flammable .
9. Clean and dry the cot before folding up, and store in protected and dry area .
10. Keep this instruction sheet as reference each time when setting up or folding the cot .
